- Reside and work in one of the regions covered by EIT Regional Innovation Scheme: Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Cyprus, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain, Türkiye, Ukraine;
- o **Be employed in the public sector** (including regional and central government officials as well as professionals working in state agencies, regulatory bodies, public universities or public research institutes).

# How and what is it delivered?

The training program is delivered as synchronous **ONLINE** training session spread over **2 days**, involving presentations, discussions, case studies, and individual and team assignments.

The program is **delivered in English** – so at least good working knowledge is required.

- **Mission-oriented Research & Innovation:** an introduction to the concept of research and innovation directed towards solving specific societal challenges; an explanation of its significance in addressing pressing issues and driving sustainable development based on Eurostat research.
- Leveraging research infrastructures (RIs) for knowledge transfer: knowledge transfer via RIs; technology transfer, spin-offs, contract R&D, analytical services and education and the opportunities for making money from commercial access to RIs; target audiences for knowledge transfer.
- Disclosure of research infrastructures "sleeping beauties": the definition of "sleeping beauties" RIs
  of scientific organisations that open opportunities for; industrial collaboration and revenue generation:
  benefits, limitations, and risks; criteria for selecting research infrastructures: identifiable, relevant, and
  competitive; strategies for awakening "sleeping beauties".
